



Future Improvements to McKeown Avenue

The widening of McKeown Avenue from Algonquin Avenue to Gormanville Road is subject to the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process. The public was previously advised of this by notices placed in the local newspaper.

Phase 1 Construction of McKeown Avenue from Algonquin Avenue to just east of Champlain Street was completed in 2010. At the present time, the City has decided to delay the future widening of McKeown Avenue.

Currently, there has been a private commercial development completed on the north side of McKeown Avenue, between Cartier Street and Champlain Street in 2011 and it is anticipated that the south side of McKeown Avenue in the same vicinity will be constructed in 2012.

Traffic control signals will be constructed and paid for through contributions from the private developers at the location of their entrances without adding additional lanes. Should additional lanes be required in the future, these will be part of the future Class Environmental Assessment process for McKeown Avenue.
