

A key step in the development of a Cultural Plan for North Bay is completing a process of cultural mapping. *Mapping is a systematic approach to identifying, recording and classifying a community's cultural resources.* To date the mapping process has involved consolidating information from a range of existing sources including Statistics Canada, local Yellow Pages, and a series of local databases. So far this has yielded a total of more than 250 assets in the various categories illustrated in the diagram below.

But we know we've only scratched the surface and now we need your help in adding to this initial information. In particular, we know that there are many individual artists that are not yet part of the database. This database will be available for public information.
