NOTICE OF STUDY COMMENCEMENT**

The City of North Bay is conducting a Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Study for upgrades to the Ferguson Street storm water collection system. The purpose of this Class EA study is to assess the environmental impacts of upgrading the existing storm water collection system in the Ferguson Street area to minimize flooding as a result of the collection of minor and major overland storm water.

The upgrades to the storm water collection system are being planned under Schedule 'B' of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (October 2000 as amended in 2007).
