**Notice of Study Completion**

The Corporation of the City of North Bay (City) has completed a Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (Class EA) Study to evaluate road widening alternatives to service the existing and future development in the Trout Lake area of the city. This study was executed in accordance with the planning and design process for Schedule 'B' projects as outlines in the Municipal Engineers Association Municipal Class Environmental Assessment document (October 2000, as amended in 2007).

The preferred alternative consists of no road widening and an improved signalized intersection.

Subject to comments received as a result of this Notice and receipt of necessary approvals, the City intends to proceed with the design and construction of this project.
