## BY-LAW NO. 2005-149

## BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC & PARKING BY-LAW NO. 2002-001 SCHEDULE 18 (NO PARKING AREAS AT ANY TIME) & SCHEDULE 21 (PARKING PROHIBITED FOR RESTRICTED PERIODS)

WHEREAS the *Municipal Act, 2001*, (S.O. 2001, c.25) authorizes the Council to pass By-laws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

**AND WHEREAS** the *Highway Traffic Act,* R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass By-laws regulating traffic on highways;

**AND WHEREAS** the amendments to Schedule 18 (No Parking Areas At Any Time) and Schedule 21 (Parking Prohibited For Restricted Periods) were authorized by Resolution No. 2005-451 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting held on Monday, June 20, 2005.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That Schedule 18 to Traffic & Parking By-law No. 2002-001 is hereby amended by adding the following:

Road	<u>Side</u>	From	<u>To</u>
SECTION "A"			
"Algonquin Avenue	both	Lansdowne Avenue	Highway 11/17"

2. That Schedule 21 to Traffic & Parking By-law No. 2002-001 is hereby amended by deleting the following:

<u>Road</u>	<u>Side</u>	<u>Between</u>	<b>Prohibited</b>
"Algonquin Avenue	east	Greenwood Avenue & Elmwood Avenue	11:30 a.m – 1:30 p.m. 4:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m."

3. That this by-law comes into effect upon being passed.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 11<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JULY, 2005.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 11<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JULY, 2005.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 11<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF JULY, 2005.
