BY-LAW NO. 1965

BEING A BY-LAW to establish, regulate and govern Municipal Parking lots for vehicles in the City of North Bay.

WHEREAS it is deemed expedient to establish municipal parking lots for vehicles within the City of North Bay and to regulate and govern such parking lots and to and collect a fee for such parking.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:-

1. The City will establish on lands already acquired or to be acquired by separate By-law, either by purchase or by lease, one or more municipal parking lots for vehicles, each of which shall be designated and shall be referred to herein as a "Civic Car Park", to be regulated and governed as hereinafter provided.
2. Every Civic Car Park shall be open to the public for the parking of mechanically operated and mechanically drawn vehicles not exceeding 19 feet in overall length including any load carried upon or attached to such vehicle. No other type of vehicle shall be parked therein.
3. Every vehicle parked in a Civic Car Park must be brought to rest and braked at right angles to and against the concrete marker, block or bumper or other device provided, and entirely within and parallel to the side limit or lines provided for the demarcation of each parking stall. No vehicle shall be parked at an angle to, or so as to extend beyond such side limits.
4. Unless special stalls so designated are provided for vehicles with trailers and available, every trailer, immediately upon entering the Civic Car Park, shall be unhitched from its vehicle and parked in a separate stall in such a manner as to conform with all regulations governing the parking of vehicles herein.
5. Every person who brings a vehicle or trailer to be parked in a Civic Car Park, immediately upon bringing such vehicle or trailer to rest in the parked position shall deposit in the meter provided for each parking stall, the appropriate parking fee as indicated on each such parking meter and it shall be the responsibility of such person to ensure that such deposit is adequate to cover the length of time that each such vehicle remains in such parking stall.
6. Every parking fee shall be deposited in coin of Canada or the United States of America in denominations of 5¢, 10¢ or 25¢ and no other coin, device or other object whatsoever shall be used to operate any meter. Any person damaging or in any way preventing the normal operation of any meter shall be held liable for any damage or loss incurred by his or her improper act.
7. In any Civic Car Park there may be provided certain parking stalls each of which may be allotted to one person at a monthly rate of \$10.00 or such other rate as City Council may from time to time decide, provided such monthly rate is paid to the City of North Bay on or before the 15th day of the month preceding the month for which such rate is paid. Each such parking stall shall be marked "Restricted Parking" and no stall so marked shall be used by anyone other than the person who has paid the rate for that stall.
8. No person shall enter or leave any Civic Car Park with any vehicle except by an entrance or exit designated as such and no person shall obstruct any such entrance or exit or other portion of a Civic Car Park so as to delay or hinder the normal and proper passage of vehicles into, out of, or within such car park at any time.

9. Every Civic Car Park shall be operated and the provisions relating thereto enforced during the hours between 8:00 a.m. and midnight on every day except Sundays and statutory and Civic holidays and during such excepted times and days, all of **the** provisions relating to Civic Car Parks shall remain in full force and effect excepting only that no fee will be charged; provided further, however, that no person shall bring any vehicle into a Civic Car Park or allow it to remain there during the hours from midnight to 8:00 a.m. on any morning during the period in each year when snow removal is required.

10. Notwithstanding anything contained in this By-law and any other representation, holding out, or information pertaining to Civic Car Parks, the City of North Bay shall not be responsible for loss of or damage to any vehicle, accessories, contents or other private goods or materials nor shall the City of North Bay be held responsible for personal injury suffered by any person within the limits of the Civic Car Park from any cause whatsoever or by reason of the act of any person other than an employee, agent or servant of the said City of North Bay.

11. This By-law shall be administered and enforced by the Police Department of the City of North Bay and any other person or persons authorized for such purpose.

12. Every person committing a breach of the provisions of this By-law shall be liable, on summary conviction to a penalty of not less than \$2.00 and not more than \$300.00 together with such costs as the convicting Magistrate may fix, provided however, that any person against whom such breach, and failing such payment, than the provisions of The Summary Convictions Act shall apply.


13. This By-law shall take effect as of the day of its final passing.
