THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 56-88

A BY-LAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF O.N.R. TRAIN WHISTLES AT LEVEL CROSSINGS IN THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS section 138 of the Environmental Protection Act, R.S.O. 180, c. 141, authorizes the council to pass by-laws, subject to the approval of the Minister of the Environment, regulating or prohibiting the emission of sounds;

AND WHEREAS section 155 of the Railways Act of Ontario, relieves the Ontario Northland Railway of the obligation to sound a railway train engine whistle approaching a highway crossing where a municipal by-law is in force prohibiting the sounding of the whistle;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to prohibit the sounding of any railway train engine whistle where the Ontario Northland Railway crosses Lees Road, Highway 11 North and Franklin Street in the City of North Bay.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The sounding of any railway train engine whistle at the following highway crossings in the City of North Bay is hereby prohibited: Temagami Subdivision:

Mileage	Street
1.21	Franklin Street
1.36	Highway 11 North
3.93	Lees Road

2. This by-law shall come into force on the day on which it is approved by the Minister of the Environment of Ontario.

READ A FIRST TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 25th DAY OF APRIL , 1988.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 9TH DAY OF MAY , 1988.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 9TH DAY OF MAY , 1988.
