BY-LAW NO. 2009-250

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND TRAFFIC & PARKING BY-LAW NO. 2002-001(TO PROVIDE FOR TOW AWAY ZONES)

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, 2001, (S.O. 2001, c.25) authorizes the Council to pass Bylaws regulating or prohibiting certain traffic on highways and regulating or prohibiting parking on highways;

AND WHEREAS the *Highway Traffic Act,* R.S.O. 1990, Chapter H-8, as amended, authorizes the Council to pass By-laws regulating traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS an amendment to Traffic By-Law 2002-01 to provide for tow away zones where official signs are on display was authorized by Resolution No. 2009-638 passed by Council at its Regular Meeting held on Monday, October 5, 2009;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Section 40 of By-law No. 2002-001 is hereby renumbered as 40(1).
- 2. By-Law 2002-001 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:
 - "40(2) Where official signs are on display, any vehicle found to be parked in contravention of this By-Law may be towed, removed and impounded at the direction of a Police Officer, By-Law Enforcement Officer or the Managing Director of Public Works or his authorized delegates, at the sole risk and expense of the owner of such vehicle."
- 3. This By-Law comes into effect upon being passed.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THIS 14TH DAY OF DECEMBER, 2009.
