

**THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY**

**BY-LAW NO. 2009-113**

**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 74-88  
(A BY-LAW TO REGULATE OWNERS OF DOGS – STOOP & SCOOP)**

**WHEREAS** Council passed General Government Committee Report No. 2009-04 at its Regular Meeting held on Monday, April 27, 2009 to amend By-law No. 74-88 to allow the by-law to be applied to private property on notice from a By-law Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 2 is hereby deleted and the following inserted in lieu thereof:
  - “2. (a) Every person who owns or harbours a dog shall forthwith remove and dispose of any excrement left by the dog on any public property within the City of North Bay,
  - (b) Every person who owns or harbours a dog shall forthwith remove and dispose of any excrement left by the dog on private property within 24 hours of the deposit.
  - (c) Any Officer enforcing this By-Law may order excrement to be removed from private property within 24 hours by the person whom the officer reasonably believes to be the person who owns or harbours the dog believed to be responsible for the excrement.”
2. Section 4 is hereby deleted and the following inserted in lieu thereof:
  - “4. (a) This by-law shall be enforced by the employees of the North Bay and District Humane Society, By-Law Enforcement Officers, Provincial Offences Officers and by any police officer.
  - (b) In the event that dog excrement is not removed when so ordered under this by-law then on a second or subsequent occasion the officer may give notice of the order to the owner of the premises.
  - (c) If dog excrement is not removed within 24 hours of notice to the owner pursuant to paragraph (b), then the officer is authorized to arrange for the removal of the excrement at the expense of the owner of the premises and the cost thereof shall be added to the tax roll for the private property and collected in like manner as municipal taxes.”
3. This By-law comes into effect upon being passed.
