THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 97-90

BEING A BY-LAW TO TEMPORARILY CLOSE PART OF BIRCH'S ROAD, FERRIS DRIVE AND BOOTH ROAD.

WHEREAS pursuant to the request of the North Bay Knight's Cycling Club, it is deemed expedient to temporarily close portions of Birch's Road, Ferris Drive and Booth Road pursuant to the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, Section 208, Subsection 44.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- That the portion of Birch's Road from Booth Road to Ferris Drive, Ferris Drive from Birch's Road to Booth Road and Booth Road from Ferris Drive to Birch's Road, in the City of North Bay, be and the same is hereby closed from 10:00 o'clock in the forenoon until 4:00 o'clock in the afternoon on Sunday, the 3rd day of June, 1990, for the purpose of a bicycle race.
- 2. That the City Engineer is hereby authorized to have barricades and warning devices erected to carry out the said closure.
- 3. That prior to 5:00 o'clock in the afternoon on the 3rd day of June, 1990, the North Bay Knight's Cycling Club will attend to the restoration of the said portion of Birch's Road, Ferris Drive and Booth Road to its condition prior to the above closure.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 28TH DAY OF MAY, 1990.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND ENACTED AND PASSED THE $28\mathrm{TH}$ DAY OF MAY , 1990.
