BY-LAW NO. 154-95

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 33-88 BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE FENCES AND TO REQUIRE FENCES AROUND SWIMMING POOLS

WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it desirable to amend the Fence By-law.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) That Fence By-law No. 33-88 be amended by deleting Section 3 from the By-law and inserting the following section:
 - "No person shall erect, construct, alter or maintain a fence containing barbed wire or electricity, save and except on those properties indicated on Schedule "A" hereto. The use of said fencing shall be exclusively for storage compounds on commercial or industrial property that may:
 - a) have a maximum of three strands of barbed wire;
 - b) be constructed in such a fashion as to lean inward at the top of the fence, and
 - c) be located at the top of the fence no less than 8' to the first strand of barbed wire from grade."
- 2) This By-law comes into force and effect upon being finally passed.
