**BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND THE SNOW
MACHINES BY-LAW TO ALLOW A DEFINED
ACCESS ROUTE TO THE JACK PINE HILL**

WHEREAS the Snowmobile By-law No. 11-95 regulates and governs the operation of motorized snow machines within the municipality;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to define an access route from Armstrong Park to the Jack Pine Hill.


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. Schedule "A" (Urban Area) of By-law No. 11-95 is hereby deleted and the attached Schedule "A" inserted in lieu thereof.
2. Schedule "B" (Parklands) of By-law No. 11-95 is hereby amended by adding the following:
"Armstrong Park: From Armstrong Park to the Jack Pine Hill, along Lakeside Drive to Trout Lake Road to the Ontario Northland Railway underpass to Ski Club Road to the Jack Pine Hill."
3. The attached Schedule "E" is hereby added as Schedule "E" to By-law No. 11-95.
4. This by-law shall not come into effect until the City Clerk receives a certificate from the City Engineer that all necessary permits and signs are in place for this Jack Pine Hill route.

Trail Location

From - To

Armstrong Park

Northerly along the east side of Lakeside Drive from Armstrong Park to the north side of Trout Lake Road;

Then westerly along the north side of Trout Lake Road to the underpass under the Ontario Northland Railway;

Then northerly through the underpass under the Ontario Northland Railway to the north side of Ski Club Road;

Then westerly along the north side of Ski Club Road to the TransCanada Pipeline right-of-way;

Then westerly along the Ontario Hydro right-of-way to Jack Pine Hill.
