

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 17-72

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2100 OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE ADOPTION OF CERTAIN POLICY MATTERS.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of North Bay considers it advisable to amend said By-law;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT Paragraph 15 of By-law No. 2100 be replaced and the following substituted therefore:
 - 15. COMMITTEE MEETINGS
 - (a) That there shall be no public presentations at Committee meetings;
 - (b) That all Committee meetings be open to the public provided that matters declared by the Chairman of a Committee to be of a confidential nature shall be discussed in camera at the end of the meeting. Upon completion of the business of the meeting, other than those matters declared to be of a confidential nature, the Mayor or the member of Council presiding, shall cause the hall to be cleared of all persons other than the reporters for newspapers and radio and television broadcasting stations or persons invited by the Mayor or Chairman of a Committee to be present for the assistance of the Council. Such reporters shall be entitled to be present for the purpose of obtaining background information and shall not be entitled to publish any of the discussions in camera except such items as may be specifically permitted by the Chairman of the Committee concerned.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND FINALLY ENACTED AND PASSED THIS 7TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 1972.
