

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY

BY-LAW NO. 31-96

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROHIBIT THE DEPOSITING OF SNOW
ON ANY HIGHWAY OR BRIDGE OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY.

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M 45, Section 314(1), paragraph 1 empowers municipalities to prohibit the deposit of any snow on any highway or bridge within the municipality;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. No person shall deposit or cause to be deposited any snow or ice upon any portion of any highway or bridge located within the territorial limits of the Corporation of the City of North Bay.
2. No person shall move snow within the street allowance from one side of the cleared portion of the street allowance intended for vehicular and pedestrian traffic, to the other side of the street allowance.
3. No person shall relocate snow within the street allowance in such a manner as to encroach on the cleared portion of the street allowance intended for vehicular and pedestrian traffic, or that would result in the obstruction of normal visibility of the safe movement of vehicular and pedestrian traffic on the street allowance.
4. By-law No. 87-72 of the City of North Bay and any amendments thereto is hereby repealed.
5. Any person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and subject to a fine recoverable under the Provincial Offences Act.
