THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY BY-LAW NO. 63-87

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 120-86, BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 28-80 THE CITY OF NORTH BAY CONSOLIDATED ZONING BY-LAW. (FLOOD AND EROSION AREAS)

WHEREAS By-Law No. 120-86, a By-Law amending the City of North Bay Zoning By-Law to recognize and protect certain areas susceptible to flood and erosion damage has been approved by City Council and has been circulated to affected owners;

AND WHEREAS one objection has been received to By-Law No. 120-86;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay deems it desirable to amend By-Law 120-86 to satisfy the objection;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-Law No. 120-86 is hereby amended by deleting the Schedule "R" attached to By-Law No. 120-86 and inserting therefore Schedule "A" attached hereto as the revised Schedule "R".
- 2. (a) Notice of this By-Law shall be given by the Clerk in the manner and form and to the persons prescribed by Ontario Regulation 404/83, not later than 15 days after the day this By-Law is passed.
 - (b) Where no notice of appeal is filed with the Clerk of The Corporation of The City of North Bay within thirty-five (35) days from the passing of this By-Law, then this By-Law shall be deemed to have come into force on the day it was passed.
 - (c) Where one or more notices of appeal are filed with the Clerk of The Corporation of The City of North Bay within thirty-five (35) days from the passing of this By-Law setting out the objection, then this By-Law shall not come into force until all appeals have been finally disposed of, whereupon the By-Law shall be deemed to have come into force on the day it was passed.

READ A SECOND TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL THE 8TH DAY OF JUNE 1987.

READ A THIRD TIME IN OPEN COUNCIL AND PASSED THIS 8TH DAY OF JUNE 1987.
