BY-LAW NO. 123-84

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 28-80 AS AMENDED BY BY-LAW NO. 163-83 TO ADD A PERMITTED USE TO THE "INDUSTRIAL SPECIAL ZONE NO. 14 (M.5 SP.14)" (PELTOMAA)

WHEREAS the owner of a property within the M.5 Sp.14 Zone has requested a rezoning to allow the construction of a single family dwelling for his own use;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to add single family dwelling for the resident owner as a permitted use to the M.5 Sp.14 Zone;

AND WHEREAS the Council of The Corporation of the City of North Bay has ensured that adequate information has been made available to the public and has held at least one public meeting after due notice for the purpose of informing the public of this By-law;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed desirable to amend Section 11.4.14.2(a) of By-law No. 28-80 pursuant to Section 34 of The Planning Act;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY ERBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Seciton 11.4.14.2.(a) of By-law No. 28-80 is amended by adding the following words to the list of permitted uses: "Accessory uses to the above including a single family dwelling unit for the resident owner, either as part of the main building or detached."
- 2.(a) Notice of this By-law shall be given by the Clerk in the manner and form and to the persons prescribed by Ontario Regulation 404/83, not later than 15 days after the day this by-law is passed.
 - (b) Where no notice of appeal is filed with the Clerk of

 The Corporation of the City of North Bay within thirty
 five (35) days from the passing of this By-law, then this

 By-law shall be deemed to have come into force on the day

 it was passed.
 - (c) Where one or more notices of appeal are filed with the Clerk of the Corporation of the City of North Bay within thirty-five days (35) days from the passing of this By-law setting

out the objection, then this By-law shall not come into force until all appeals have been finally disposed of, whereupon the By-law shall be deemed to have come into force on the day it was passed.
