BY-LAW NO. 13 -96

**A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 83-93 TO
IMPOSE SEPTAGE TREATMENT CHARGES ON
SEPTIC SYSTEM PUMPOUTS TO SANITARY
SEWERS.**

WHEREAS the Council has passed By-Law 85-93 to regulate the use of the municipal sanitary sewer system;

AND WHEREAS the cost of the municipal sanitary sewer system is charged only to the Urban Service Area within the City of North Bay;

AND WHEREAS the septage from septic system pumpouts from outside the Urban Service Area and from outside the City limits are being discharged to the municipal sanitary sewer system by haulers licensed by the Ministry of the Environment and Energy, which impose an additional cost for treatment on the Urban Service Area;

AND WHEREAS the Council has passed By-Law 203-92 to require the pumpout of septic tanks adjacent to Trout Lake;

AND WHEREAS the Council is authorized to regulate the use of its sanitary sewer system pursuant to Section 210 (83)(84)(85) of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M-45.

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF NORTH BAY HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. Sewer Use By-Law No. 4-87 is hereby amended by adding the following clauses:

"14.2 (1) In this section "septage waste water" means sewage originating in a domestic septic system, or commercial, institutional or industrial waste water originating from within the corporate limits of the City of North Bay but which use is not connected by sewermain to the Water Pollution Control Plant of the City. The Director may approve applications made from outside the corporate limits of the City of North Bay.

"14.2 (2) No person shall discharge septage waste water from lands which are not directly connected to and serviced by a City sewermain into a sanitary sewer of the City without a Discharge Agreement approved by the Director."

"14.2 (3) Any person wishing to discharge septage waste water into a sanitary sewer in the City shall submit an application form setting out all information required by the Director, including the license plate number of the vehicles to be used and the Ministry of Environment and Energy registration number for haulage of waste water."

"14.2 (4) Every person with a Septage Waste Water Discharge Agreement shall submit an accounting to the Director within five (5) days of the end of each month, setting out the volume of waste water discharged to the City's sanitary sewer system in the previous month and submitting the information referred to and the fees required by Schedule "B" therefore for all discharges."


- "14.2 (5) Any party to a Septage Waste Water Discharge Agreement who is in contravention of Subsection 3 may be prohibited from use of the sanitary sewer system for the discharge of septage by order of the Director."
- "14.2(6) No person shall discharge septage waste water into a sanitary sewer of the City in contravention of an order by the Director under Section 14.2(5)."
- "14.2 (7) Any party to a Septage Waste Water Discharge Agreement shall enable the Director to carry out such audit as may be required for the purpose of determining compliance with this By-Law."
- "14.2 (8) The fees set out in Schedule "B" hereto shall be paid to the City by the person holding a Waste Discharge Agreement for each pumpout by such person which is discharged to a municipal sanitary sewer."
- "14.2 (9) Any contaminated waste water exceeding the limits of this By-Law shall require approval with respect to the content and timing by the Water Pollution Control Plant Superintendent prior to being dumped."

2. This By-Law be effective as of June 1, 1996.

SCHEDULE 'B'

The fees for dumping of septage waste water from septic tanks or holding tanks servicing domestic needs shall be as follows:

<u>DESCRIPTION</u>	<u>FEE / PUMPOUTS UP TO 1,000 GALLONS</u>
(i) Residential properties within the Urban Service Area as set out on Schedule "C" hereto.	Exempt
(ii) Residential properties within the City but beyond the Urban Service Area.	\$20.00
(iii) Commercial, institutional, industrial or other properties within the City	\$20.00 to a maximum of \$150.00/month
(iv) All properties outside of the City	\$40.00

The fees for dumping of septage waste water from commercial, institutional or industrial processes, not connected to and serviced by a City sewermain are as follows:

<u>DESCRIPTION</u>	<u>FEE / PER PUMPOUT UP TO 1,000 GALLONS</u>
(i) In compliance with the City's Sewer Use By-Law	\$20.00 to a maximum of \$150.00/month
(ii) Exceeds the limits of the Sewer Use By-Law but are suitable for treatment at the Water Pollution Control Plant under terms satisfactory to the Director:	
(I) within City limits	\$40.00
(II) outside City limits	\$100.00
(iii) For dumping of small quantities of cleaning water from licensed cleaners.	\$5.00/dump
