## **PAWNBROKER**

Applicable to:	Every Person who carries on the Business of a Pawnbroker,	
Definitions:	Pawnbrokers – means a Person who carries on the Business of taking by way of pawn or pledge any article for the repayment of money lent thereon, as defined in the <i>Pawnbrokers Act</i> , R.S.O. 1990, c.P.6, as amended.  Pawn Shop – means a Business or Premise where the business of a Pawnbroker is carried out.	
Exemptions:	NONE	
Licence Fee:	\$100.00 per year	
Application Circulated to and Approvals Required From:	City of North Bay Zoning Department.     North Bay Police Service	
Special Conditions:	<ol> <li>Every Pawnbroker shall give to the City security to the satisfaction of the City Clerk in the sum of \$2,000.00 for the due observance by the Pawnbroker under the Pawnbrokers Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.6, as amended.</li> </ol>	
	<ol> <li>The operation of the Business shall conform to the provisions of the <i>Pawnbrokers Act</i>, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.6, as amended and all applicable North Bay Police Services Board By-Laws that may be in force.</li> </ol>	
	<ol> <li>Every Pawnbroker shall provide a current Criminal Record check for all owners, operators and employees who are eighteen (18) years of age or over, which shall be obtained by them at their own expense from the North Bay Police Service or the local Police Service where they reside.</li> </ol>	
	4. For the purposes of this By-Law the initial Criminal Record Check must be dated within the last sixty (60) days of the initial Application for a Pawnbroker's Licence. All subsequent renewals for a Pawnbroker's Licence must include a Criminal Record Check that is current within the last two (2) years.
